Countdown started to celebrate Birth Centenary of the Father of the Nation

A web clock to countdown the 100th Birth anniversary of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman has been inaugurated today at Bangladesh High Commission Canberra. The web clock is placed at the homepage of the High Commission's webpage (<u>https://www.bhcanberra.com/</u>) which would cease counting at the zero hours of 17 March 2020.

To commemorate the birth centenary of the Father of the Nation, Bangladesh High Commission Canberra has already opened a *Bangabandhu Corner* in last August. It has chalked out an array of programs throughout *Mujib Year*.
