#### 35th ECM of ACECC Held

35th Executive Committee Meeting (ECM) of Asian Civil Engineering Coordinating Council(ACECC) was held recently from 8-10 October, 2018 in Melbourne hosted by Engineers Australia(EA). The program commenced on Monday, 08th October at EA Victoria Office, Level 31, 600 Bourke Street, Melbourne, VIC 3000 and was attended by 35 participants from 12 Member Societies. A team of 4members from IEB including Didarul Alam, F.ASCE, President, Bangladesh Section and led by Khandker Manjur Morshed, HGS of IEB attended the meeting.

Thereafter, 29th Planning Committee Meeting(PCM) and 24th **Technical Coordination Committee** Meeting(TCCM) were held in two successive sessions where agenda wise elaborate discussions were held. The Chair of the Award Sub-Committee, Dr. Udai Singh apprised the meeting about the status on different category of Awards. Then the participants attended Welcome Cocktail Reception & Civil College Board Award ceremony at 5:00 pm which was ended at 8:30 pm.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> day's program on 09 October started at 8:30 am and at the beginning, the minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> PCM and 24<sup>th</sup> TCCM were presented by the Secretary General which were finalised and approved. Then began the 35<sup>th</sup> ECM as per agenda including the approval of winning projects. Then the delegates

Besides, the two Prime Minister also inaugurated 2<sup>nd</sup> Bhairab and Titas rail bridge on Dhaka-Chattagram route and 'nonstop' service of Maitree Express Train between Dhaka-Kolkata. During the inauguration, the Chief Minister of West Bengal, Mamata Banerjee joined them video conference during inauguration from Kolkata. Minister Sheikh Hasina in her speech told that this kind of cooperation will create instance for reaching a greater height in the context of bilateral relation between the two country.

#### **Election Resource Centre Built**

Public Works Department (PWD) completed construction of Election Resources Centre that includes two complexes – 1) Construction of 12-

storied Election Training Institite(EIT)
